### **ALL CLASSES**

The following Code of Conduct highlights the level of expected behaviour of gymnasts inside the gym the purpose of this code is to protect the Gymnasts and the sport and maintain the excellent reputation of the club.

In all aspects the highest level of behaviour by gymnasts and parents is expected by the club at all times. Behaviour that falls below this standard will result in either verbal / written warning, disciplinary action or in extreme case dismissal from the club.

Please be aware that ignorance of the contents of this code will not be accepted as an excuse for any breach. Complaints or problems will be dealt with fairly and as quickly as possible by either the coaches who have authority to act immediately or by the **Club Welfare Officer ( Tracey Santo Tel 07908192053 email - [tracey.santo@live.co.uk](mailto:tracey.santo@live.co.uk) )** as quickly as possible after the event. The final decision on any matter rests with the Head Coach and the Management Team.

### **EXPECTATIONS OF GYMNASTS**

- All members must participate within the rules and respect the coaches, and their decisions.

- Members should keep to the agreed timings for training and competition's or informs their coach if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable attire for training and events as agreed with the coach. Club leotards, shorts and tracksuits should Keep all long hair tied back.
- Members must pay any fees for training and events promptly.
- Members should treat all equipment with respect, and should not move equipment without permission.
- Members must inform their coach of any injury or illness they may have before the warm-up begins.
- Members must not use bad language.
- Preform to you best at all times
- Laziness will not be permitted in the gym
- No jewellery including ear studs, or body piercing adornments to be worn at any time during training.
