



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS

ALL CLASSES

The following Code of Conduct highlights the level of expected behaviour of Parents inside the gym the purpose of this code is to protect the Gymnasts and the sport and maintain the excellent reputation of the club.

In all aspects the highest level of behaviour by gymnasts and parents is expected by the club at all times. Behaviour that falls below this standard will result in either verbal / written warning, disciplinary action or in extreme case dismissal from the club.

Please be aware that ignorance of the contents of this code will not be accepted as an excuse for any breach. Complaints or problems will be dealt with fairly and as quickly as possible by either the coaches who have authority to act immediately or by the Club Welfare Officer ([Tracey Santo Tel 07908192053](tel:07908192053) email - tracey.santo@live.co.uk) as quickly as possible after the event. The final decision on any matter rests with the Head Coach and the Management Team.

EXPECTATIONS OF PARENTS

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and participate within them.

- Help you child recognize good performance, not just results
- Never force your child to take part in the sport
- Keep the club informed if your child is ill.
- Always ensure your child is dressed appropriately for gym and has plenty to drink.
- Any concerns or complaints about any aspect of the club report through the approved channels.
- Never punish or belittle a child for poor performance or making mistakes.
- Always collect your child promptly at the end of a session.
- Support your child's involvement.
- Support and accept the Coaches decision.
- No filming or photos of gymnasts from viewing area, if you are found doing this you will be told to delete the film or pic. If you are found ignoring this rule you will be told to leave the gym.
